The Jumper classes will run immediately after the Show Jumping phase of the Combined Test

J1 Puddle Jumper – Open to all – course will consist of a minimum of 8 fences, 2' -2'3"

J2 Connemara Jumper – Open to All – course of a minimum of 8 fences, 2'6"

J3 Connemara Jumper – Open to all – course of a minimum of 8 fences, 2'11"

J4 Connemara Jumper – Open to All – course of a minimum of 8 fences, 3'3" to 3'6"

USEF - Time First Round (Table II, Sec. 1)—The first round is decided by adding together the faults incurred over the course and any penalties for exceeding the Time Allowed. Horses with clear rounds or equal faults are classified according to their time taken to complete the course.

MM1 Purebred Mountain & Moorland Mares: 8 years and under.

MM4 Purebred Mountain & Moorland Geldings: Over 8 years.

IN-HAND CHAMPION AND RESERVE (classes MM1-4, 1st and 2nd place winners)

MM 5 Mountain and Moorland – Walk/Trot – Walk and trot both ways of the ring.

MM 6 Mountain and Moorland Under Saddle - Walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. May be asked to halt or back and/or perform individually on the rail.

MM 7 – Mountain and Moorland Hack – Walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. Jump two 18” fences. To be judged on willingness and natural ability to jump with emphasis on manners.

RIDDEN CHAMPION AND RESERVE (classes MM5-7, highest class points earned)

CONNEMARA BREEDING CLASSES

Saturday – not before 3 p.m. – Wiley Arena

Judge: Joe Burke, IRE

In all Breeding Classes, Connemaras will be judged on Connemara breed type, correct conformation, disposition and true movement. Unruly, disruptive behavior on the part of any pony or his handler will be cause for dismissal from the ring. In Halfbred Classes, Connemara breed type shall not be a consideration.

B1 PB Connemara Yearling Filly Division. Open to all registered purebred filly foals of 2024

B2 PB Connemara Yearling Colt and Gelding Division. Open to all registered purebred colts and geldings of 2024

B3 Best PB Connemara Yearling and Reserve. No entry fee. Open to the two purebred winners. Perpetual trophy to best yearling. *(If Classes B1 and B2 are combined, this class will not be held.)*

B4 Purebred Stallions and Geldings age 2 and over. Class may be split by ages if enough entries

JS16 Junior Showmanship. Juniors 14 and under to show any age purebred or halfbred pony. Judged on presentation, turnout, and manners of pony, not conformation. No stallions. Open to all juniors – all M&M ponies handled by juniors. Winner receives prize from the Region III Boutique.

B5 Purebred Connemara Mares, Ages 2 to 7

B6 Purebred Connemara Mares, Ages 8 and over

B7 Best Connemara Purebred of the Day. Open to all 1st and 2nd placed of the previous in-hand purebred classes. No entry fee.

B8 Connemara Get of Sire. Purebred. Two or three get from the same sire shall comprise one entry made in the stallion's name. Each entry must be all purebred. One entry fee for the group.

B9 Halfbred Connemara Yearling Filly. Open to all registered halfbred filly foals of 2024.

B10 Halfbred Connemara Yearling Colt & Gelding Division. Open to all registered halfbred colt foals of 2024.

B11 Best Halfbred Connemara Yearling and Reserve. No entry fee. Open to the two halfbred futurity winners to Best Yearling. *(If Classes B10 and B11 are combined, this class will not be held.)*

B12 Halfbred Connemara Mares and Geldings. Ages 2 to 7

Champion & Reserve Ribbons, Anne Moe Memorial Trophy

R1 Shamrock Green Connemara U/S. Purebred at their first or second show. Walk/trot both ways of the ring. Judged on willingness, obedience and way of going.

R2 Shamrock Green Connemara Hunter Hack–Walk/trot both ways of the ring. Individually jump 2 fences at 18”.

R3 Shamrock Green Over Fences – Trot a course of 4 fences at 18”.

OPEN PLEASURE DIVISION Classes 4,5,6,

Champion & Reserve Ribbons, Pleasure Division Trophy

R4 Open Pleasure - Walk and trot both ways of the ring.

R5 Open Pleasure Under Saddle. Open to all. Walk/ trot/canter both ways of the ring. To stand quietly and back readily. Judged on manners, obedience, and ability to give a safe, pleasurable ride.

R6 Open Pleasure Hack. Walk/trot both ways of the ring. Individually jump 2 fences at 18”.

SHORT STIRRUP DIVISION – Classes 7,8,9

Champion & Reserve. Champion earns a Prize from the Boutique.

R7 Short Stirrup Under Saddle. Riders under 12 years. To be shown at a walk and trot both ways of the ring. Judged on hands, seat, guidance, and control of mount. Rider’s first or second year of showing – not for intermediate or advanced riders. Riders under 12 years.

R8 Short Stirrup Over Ground Poles – Trot a course of ground poles.

R9 Short Stirrup Hack:.. Walk, trot. Individually jump two fences at 18”.

R10 Short Stirrup Over Fences: Riders under 12 years. To be shown over course of four fences at 18”. Trotting permitted

LL Future Olympians – Leadline. Ponies to be ridden by beginning riders, large and small. Walk with a short trot. To be judged 50% on attitude of the pony (safe and responsive) and 50% on the attitude of the rider (competent and enthusiastic). No stallions.

HALFBRED GREEN CONNEMARA DIVISION – Classes 10,11,12

Champion & Reserve Ribbons, Trophy

For Halfbred Connemaras in their first or second year of showing.

R11 Halfbred Green Connemara Over Fences. 6 to 8 fences at 2’ to 2’3”. Trotting permitted.

R12 Halfbred Green Connemara Over Fences. 6 to 8 fences at 2’ to 2’3”. Trotting permitted.

R13 Halfbred Green Connemara Under Saddle. Walk/Trot/canter both ways of the ring. Judge may ask for a halt or back.

PUREBRED GREEN CONNEMARA DIVISION – Classes 13,14,15

Champion & Reserve Ribbons, Trophy

For purebred Connemaras in their first or second year of showing.

R14 Purebred Green Connemara Over Fences. Six to 8 fences at 2’ to 2’3”. Trotting permitted.

R15 Purebred Green Connemara Over Fences. Six to 8 fences at 2’ to 2’3”

R16 Purebred Green Connemara Under Saddle. Walk/trot/canter both ways of the ring. Judge may ask for a halt or back.

OPEN HALFBRED DIVISION – Classes 16,17,18

Champion & Reserve Ribbons, Ridgetop Connemaras Trophy, Leather Halter Donated by Linda and Melanie Trimper

R17 Halfbred Over Fences. Six to 8 fences at 2’3” – 2’6”.

R18 Halfbred Over Fences. Six to 8 fences at 2’3” – 2’6”

R19 Halfbred Connemara Under Saddle. Walk/trot/canter both ways of the ring. The judge may ask for hand gallop, halt or back.

OPEN PUREBRED DIVISION – Classes 19,20,21

Champion & Reserve Ribbons, Susan McConnell Memorial Trophy, Leather Halter donated by Linda and Melanie Trimper

R20 Purebred Connemara Over Fences. Six to 8 fences at 2’3” to 2’6”

R21 Purebred Connemara Over Fences. Six to 8 fences at 2’3” – 2’6”

R22 Purebred Connemara Under Saddle. Walk/trot/canter both ways of the ring. The judge may ask for hand gallop, halt or back.

MISCELLANEOUS CLASSES

FD Fancy Dress. Sam Davis Memorial Costume Class - Let your imagination run wild. Ponies may be led, driven or ridden. Prizes for all. No stallions.

FAM Families. Walk/trot, for groups of riders and/or Connemaras from the same family. Enthusiasm, numbers, style and ability will impress the judge. No stallions.

R23 Half Century LTD – or Vintage Class. Age of rider plus pony must be greater than 50. Walk and trot both ways of the ring. Oldest Rider, Oldest pony, Oldest combo awards.

R 24 Champagne Challenge— Riders over age 18 follow judge's orders while riding with a glass of champagne. Rider with the most left in the glass is the winner of a bottle of champagne and a ribbon.

R25 The Great Egg and Spoon Challenge. Open to all. Keep that egg on your spoon as you walk/trot/canter and possibly jump. Winner receives Perpetual Davis Cup.

NEW AWARD – The CONNEMARA DOES IT ALL TROPHY – To earn this trophy competitors must declare which FIVE classes they will enter to be considered for this award. The classes must include one dressage test, one over fences class, one trail class, (can include dressage trail), one under saddle class, and one in-hand class. Ribbons and plates for first through sixth place finishers

DRESSAGE TRAIL CLASS

Directives: Purpose to demonstrate obedience, handiness and response to rider's aids. The horse must softly accept the bit and may show more "roundness" in the parts of the test separate from the obstacles. Conditions: Test may be called. To be shown in the small (20 x 40 meter) arena. Posting is optional. Transitions into and out of the halt may be done through the walk.

DRESSAGE TRAIL TEST 1, WALK/TROT


1. A Enter working trot – ground poles are placed 10m before and after X
X – Halt and salute, proceed working trot
2. C – Track right – shallow serpentine through cones – negotiate shallow serpentine of 5 cones spaced 6 m apart inside track on long side.
3. A – Working walk – U Track right, Turn right on quarterline and negotiate U-shaped rails.
4. V-E – Halt at pickup point and pick up object. Walk to deposit point and deposit object. Pick up object on top of a barrel and walk to second barrel near E, to deposit object.
5. E – Working trot
C – Track right
A – Track left
6. A – After A, working walk – shallow serpentine through cones. After turning, transition to walk. Negotiate shallow serpentine of 5 cones spaced 6 m apart on long side.
7. R – Pick up ball -working trot, one handed. Pick up ball from top of barrel.
8. C – 20 m circle – one handed.
9. C- at end of circle, drop ball in bucket at C. Pick up both reins.
10. E – 10 m half circle to X. Halt between X and ground pole and salute.
Leave arena.

DRESSAGE TRAIL TEST 2, WALK/TROT/CANTER

1. A – enter working trot crossing ground pole at L.
X - Halt and salute. Proceed working trot.
2. I – Trot over ground pole
3. B – Negotiate shallow serpentine through cones. Negotiate shallow serpentine of 5 cones spaced 6 m apart, inside track on long side.
4. V – Halt between barrel and rail.
Rein back 3-4 steps.
Proceed working walk back to barrel.
5. V-E – Halt at pick up point, and pick up object. Walk to deposit point and deposit object.
6. E – Working trot
C – Canter, 20 m circle right lead
7. M-E – Change rein, working trot near centerline.
8. A – Working walk, release reins. Negotiate shallow serpentine through cones on a loose rein.
9. R – Pick up reins and then pick up ball from top of barrel.

C – Working trot – one handed 20 m circle. At the end of the circle, drop ball in bucket at C, pick up both reins.
10. E – 10m half circle to X. Halt between X and ground pole and salute.
Leave arena.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION – PLEASE READ BEFORE COMPLETING ENTRY FORM

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS – The following must be included with ALL entry forms. Entries received without these items will not be given a back number until they are received. If the missing items are not received by the closing date for the pre-entries, the entrant will be charged an additional \$5 per class.

1. A copy of current negative Coggins for each pony – blood drawn after July 27, 2024. This must be provided to the 2025 Show Management BEFORE the entry can be allowed on the show grounds. No copying facilities are available at the show.
2. A copy of each pony's registration papers (or temporary foal certificates for ponies under age 2). This includes Mountain and Moorland entries. If your pony is included on the "On file" list you do NOT need to submit a copy. Check the appropriate blank on the entry blank.
3. A check made payable to ACPS REGION III to cover entries, including stabling fees if stalls are to be used, and haul-in fee if no stall is needed.
4. A fully completed entry form with signatures of each owner/agent and rider (or parents/guardians/trainer if a minor – form on releases below

DRESSAGE – All dressage and combined test competitors MUST pre-enter and entries must be postmarked by July 19, 2025. There are NO post entries. Entries in D7 (test of choice) and D8 (self-expression) Must indicate year, level, and test on the entry form. Entries in D8 that require music must provide their own music, equipment, and operator. Please indicate on entry form whether a small or standard arena is necessary. All tests may be read.

EMT: FIRE/RESCUE: 911

Upon arrival in the Virginia Horse Center, all trailers and campers MUST check in at the Welcome Center/Stable Office

1. No Smoking allowed in Coliseum or Barns... This is the law.
2. **VEHICLES:** Drive Carefully – Obey all traffic signs. Speed limits are strictly enforced. *Every vehicle driver must have a valid driver's license and proof of insurance.* Four wheelers and ATV's are NOT permitted on the VHC grounds. Non-powered scooters, bicycles, skateboards, in-line skates, heelers (skates in shoes) are not permitted in the Coliseum or the interior of any of the barns. The VHC reserves the right to prohibit the operation of any vehicle.
3. **Dogs/Pets:** All dogs/pets must have current inoculations for rabies as prescribed by state of residency. No loose dogs/pets are allowed anywhere on the premises. All dogs/pets that are not crated must be on a handheld or tied leash. Loose dogs/pets will incur a \$100 fine. You must clean up after your dog/pet. **COLISEUM:** Absolutely NO loose dogs/pets allowed in the Coliseum, no dogs/pets are allowed in food service areas of the Coliseum with the exception of service dogs. Absolutely no dogs/pets in the Mezzanine (2nd floor of the building) under any circumstances with the exception of Service Dogs. Please have vest on the Service Dog.
4. No trash or sharps in the manure pits. Sharps should be placed in the red boxes in barns. *Shows will be charged \$1000 for sharps in the manure pits.*
5. **ALCOHOL:** At events serving alcohol, all ABC laws must be followed. If asked to provide identification for purposes of age validation, you must comply. Those individuals who do not comply will not be served alcohol. Disorderly patrons will be removed from the premises.
6. **Theft/Vandalism:** Anyone involved in destroying property or found stealing property will be prosecuted to the fullest extent possible.
7. All horse stalls must have at least one bale of shavings or straw. Sawdust is prohibited. Shavings may be purchased at the Welcome Center (Stable Office).
8. No lunging in posted rings. No lunging is ever allowed in Wiley, Northern, Sandy Gerald, East Complex, Anderson, Tardy, and DeeDee.
9. No overnight horses may be stabled in trailers or tied out.
10. Horses are not allowed to be ponied behind any moving vehicles.
11. No vehicles allowed in the barns.

12. Campers must register at Stable Office.
13. Check-In time and Check-Out time subject to show date.
14. No gray water is to be dumped on the ground. Sewage arrangements are made through the stable office.
15. Campfires are not permitted.
16. Campers must keep their sites clean and dispose of refuse in the receptacles provided.
17. All central service buildings and other facilities in the campground are for campers and exhibitors' use only.
18. Firearms and fireworks are not permitted.
19. No tent, camper, RV or camping equipment shall be left unattended longer than 24 hours without written permission from campground management.
20. Any loss, theft, accident, or disturbance should be reported to the Virginia Horse Center Security at 540- 784-0156. Lost and Found is in the Security Office.
21. Virginia Horse Center management reserves the right to remove from the premises any camper or visitor who is in violation of these rules and regulations.
22. The Virginia Horse Center shall be held harmless against all claims, costs, losses or liability of every nature and kind asserted against or incurred by camper arising or resulting in any respect from camper's occupancy and use of premises, and/or visitor and visitor's use of premises.
23. There will be a FINE for anything hooked to or suspended from electrical conduit in the barns. This is extremely dangerous and electrocution could occur.

RELEASE: The Annual Region III Connemara Pony show is an Equine Activity conducted in accordance with the Code of Virginia, Equine Limited Liability Act, Section 3.1-796.130 et sq. (the "Act"). Horses and ponies and other equines are intrinsically dangerous and unpredictable animals. There are conditions that are an integral part of equine activities, including but not limited to, (i) the propensity of equines to behave in ways that may result in injury, harm, or death to persons on or around them; (ii) the unpredictability of an equine's reaction to such things as sounds, sudden movement, and unfamiliar objects, persons, or other animals; (iii) certain hazards such as surface and subsurface conditions; (iv) collisions with other animals or objects; and (v) the potential of a participant acting in a negligent manner that may contribute to injury to the participant or others, such as failing to maintain control over the equine or not acting within the participant's ability. I acknowledge and accept the limitations imposed upon me by the Act and waive any right to suit against the ACPS, ACPS Region III, the Virginia Horse Center, and all of their officers, directors, employees, volunteers, sponsors, and/or patrons.
